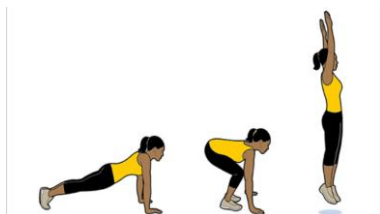


## The KFOS Fitness Challenge
