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<p>Maths focus: Create and solve 5 mathematical problems using Roman numerals.</p>	<p>Maths focus: Create a board game which will teach the children from other year groups about the Tudors.</p>
<p>English focus: Write a story about a King/Queen/Prince or Princess who possesses a unique, magical gift.</p>	<p>English focus: Write a diary about the Great Fire of London in 1666, describing what it was like to be caught up in the event.</p>
<p>DT focus: Build a model of the famous Tudor Ship, the Mary Rose, using any materials you wish.</p>	<p>DT focus: Design and make a Norman shield that could have been used during the Battle of Hastings.</p>
<p>Music focus: Research traditional Tudor instruments and produce an information booklet about them.</p>	<p>Music focus: Write a song about the Tudors that is written to the music of the famous Tudor 'Greensleeves'. You might even want to take a video of you performing it!</p>
<p>Art focus: Design and make a coronation crown using materials of your choice.</p>	<p>Art focus: Paint or sketch a portrait of any king or queen who has reigned in Britain since 1066.</p>
<p>Geography focus: Find out about Sir Francis Drake and produce a poster about his life.</p>	<p>P.E. focus: Make a rule book for the famous Tudor sport, jousting. Your rule book should contain diagrams as well as information.</p>
<p>History focus: Write a menu for a Norman royal banquet. Once you have done this, you could also design an invitation to this event.</p>	<p>History focus: Create your own information poster or booklet about Henry VIII and all of his wives.</p>
