What is Bag2School?

Bag2School is a scheme designed to help schools raise funds whilst protecting the environment at the same time - by diverting unwanted but reusable clothing and accessories away from landfill. All suitable items are sold for re-use (mainly in Eastern Europe, Africa & Asia).

How do I take part?

All children will be receiving one 'Bag 2 School' bag in their book bags this week. Additional bags will be available from both school offices should you require more than one; you can also use your own bags if easier. There is no limit to how many bags you can fill/donate. The more we collect, the more money we make.

What items can I put in the bag?

Bag2School collect good quality:

- Adult and children's clothing - including lingerie and socks (no school uniform)
- Paired shoes (tied together or with an elastic band around them)
- Handbags/bags
- Hats, scarves, ties, belts
- Soft toys

Sorry but **NO** bedding, pillows, cushions, curtains, towels, household linen, workwear, school uniforms or bric-a-brac. Thanks!

How you can help!
