Year 3 Trip to Butser Ancient Farm and Stone Age Day

Dear Parent/Guardian,

As a school, we are passionate about engaging the children in their learning and giving them the opportunity to also learn outside of the classroom. Therefore, we are delighted to inform you that the children will have two exciting learning opportunities related to our topic, to enjoy after half term.

We have arranged for the children to take part in a Stone Age themed day on Wednesday 14th November 2018. This will be led by 'Portals to the Past,' who we have worked with in previous years. Further information about Stone Age Day will be given to you after half term. We have also organised a trip to Butser Ancient Farm on Wednesday 7th November 2018 as one of our off site practical learning experiences.

We welcome parent helpers on all of our trips so please let us know if you are available to help on the trip to Butser Ancient Farm. Your child's class teacher will contact you as soon as possible to let you know if your help is needed. All helpers will need a current DBS with the school, so please ensure you organise this with the school office as soon as you find out if your help is required on this particular trip.

In order for us to leave school at 8.45 am, your child will need to go straight to their classroom that morning when the school gates open at 8.30 am. As we will arrive back at school for 3.10pm, the children can be collected as usual at the school gate.

On this occasion, your child will not need to wear their school uniform for the trip, but please ensure your child wears suitable clothing for the activities. Throughout the day, your child will be participating in a range of activities including chalk carving, pottery, archaeology and jewellery making. Therefore, a warm, waterproof jacket as well as a pair of trainers or wellington boots, are essential for this trip as your child will be outdoors for the majority of the day. Please can you also provide your child with a healthy snack, a nut free packed lunch and water bottle in a named backpack. If your child suffers from travel sickness or requires any other medication, please inform your child's class teacher before the day of our trip.

If you would like your child to attend this trip and participate in the Stone Age workshop, there is a cost of £23.00. Please make your payment through Tucasi by Monday 29th October 2018. If you require any financial assistance for this trip, please make an appointment with the Federation Headteacher via the School Office.
