Thank you for all of your responses to the Home Learning Google Questionnaire which was sent out last Friday. We have had the opportunity to look at them and are delighted that so many of your children are able to access the activities independently with enthusiasm.

Responses/Comments and Suggestions

Sadly, teachers are unable to respond directly to each and every one of your comments or suggestions as they are currently working collaboratively in teams; some in school and some remotely from home. Please be reassured that all of your responses, comments and suggestions are read to ensure we identify any trends. These trends will enable teachers to further tailor Home Learning activities ensuring that they meet the needs of all learners.

Home Learning Expectations

From reading your responses we can see that some of you are concerned about supporting your children at home. Please can we reassure you that your child does not need to be sat learning at a table for the equivalent of the school day. We understand that the children will learn differently at home to how they would at school, so the resources provided are to be used as a support for them and you. The aim of these resources is for the children to be able to access them as independently as possible. You may feel that just having time together as a family, baking a cake, playing a game or building a den in the garden is more beneficial. Please do not feel pressurised to complete all of the activities set and find a balance of Home Learning and practical activities that is right for you and your children. We are also adding other activities such as Boredom Busters and PE activities so keep an eye on your year group pages.

Challenge/Stretch

Home Learning activities are designed so that children can access, revisit and consolidate learning that has been introduced whilst they have been at school. Children will then be able to make connections in learning and build on skills that they are familiar with and apply this knowledge to new Home Learning tasks and activities.
